Dear Chautauqua Yacht Club Members:

Spring is here, and our first starting gun will be fired sooner than we think, with the first race of the July series on June 27th. We will try to have a practice race on Sunday, June 21, depending on the Lightning District Schedule.

All C-Scow sailors are reminded that the 2009 Eastern C-Scow Regatta is being hosted at Chautauqua, this June 13th and 14th, and you can register to participate on our web site www.chautauquayc.org. Stuart Strother and David Beeson are running the regatta this year, so plan to show up and support the regatta.

All Lightning sailors should know that the **2009 Lake Eric District Regatta is being held at Chautauqua this June 20 and 21**. Tim Scanlon is chairing the regatta, and he has indicated that the details of the regatta can be found on the Lightning Class web site www.lightningclass.org. Hit the Racing button and go to the calendar and then event calendar and you will find it listed in June.

New Racing Rules of Sailing have been issued by US Sailing for the 2009-2012 period. The change that may impact us the most is a change to rule 18 Mark Room. This rule refers to the zone, "the area around a mark within a distance of three hull lengths of the boat nearer to it. A boat is in the zone when any part of her hull is in the zone". Within the zone the right of way boat must be given Mark-Room, "room for a boat to sail to the mark, and then room to sail her proper course while at the mark. However, mark-room does not include room to tack unless the boat is overlapped to windward and on the inside of the boat required to give mark room". You should familiarize yourselves with this new right of way rule at marks.

I hope to be able to forward more information on this subject with your dues receipt.

Enclosed, you will find two membership registration forms for the CYC 2009 Season – one for you and another for your primary crew or a potential new member. If you are not racing any longer, please consider a social membership and remain active in our club.

As in past years, we encourage the "Commodore" membership level for those members who are able to help add reserves to the club's treasury, to be able to absorb any unexpected expenses.

Please include your current e-mail address on the registration form. We have had good success communicating with the membership via e-mail, but we do not yet have every member's e-mail address. So, please include your preferred address so you are able to receive all the summer notices

Continuing our support of Chautauqua Institution, there is a section for pre-registering for the **Old First Night Race**, which will be held on Saturday, August 1st this year. To participate in this competition you must make a donation (minimum of \$10.00) **payable by SEPARATE CHECK to Chautauqua Institution**.

The 2009 Season racing schedule is included here as well as a current list of officers, directors and staff.

This summer we have scheduled one Sail-In in the middle of the season, hoping that all the sailors will attend. It is being held at Debbie & Marty Digel's cottage on Prendergast Point and will be on Saturday, August 1st, following the races.

Last season the Board approved the addition of several race courses that could be used on Saturdays, to allow each fleet to have two races and not require the committee boat to move up and down the course. These courses have a mid-leg start and finish, and the starting line was closed on the downwind legs. Your Board of Directors has elected to continue the courses in our sailing instructions, but **the starting line will <u>not</u> be closed during the race**.
